PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, the Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month observance, now in its 21st year, is designed to help people understand that recovery is possible; and
- WHEREAS, approximately 640,000 Hoosiers were classified with a serious substance use disorder in the past year; and
- WHEREAS, treatment helps reduce reported job problems, including incomplete work and absenteeism, by an average of 75 percent; and
- WHEREAS, it is important to ensure that such services are readily available to those in need; and
- WHEREAS, Indiana Alcohol and Drug Addiction Recovery Month calls upon Hoosiers to observe this month with appropriate programs, activities, and ceremonies supporting this year's theme, "Join the Voices for Recovery: Now More Than Ever;"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 2010 as
